Pitfalls in the measurement and interpretation of thyroid function tests. When a person's dose of thyroid medication is adjusted, the American Thyroid Association recommends waiting weeks before testing the level of TSH. A thyroid stimulating hormone TSH test is a common blood test used to evaluate how well the thyroid gland is working.

Therefore, providers need to rely on biochemical testing to confirm or rule out. Beyond the TSH, assessment of free T4 is the most commonly ordered thyroid function test. In five studies involving a total of patients with empty sella, the prevalence of central hypothyroidism was 0— Table 1 lists common patterns of thyroid function tests and their interpretation, assuming an intact hypothalamic-pituitary-thyroid axis and the absence of significant non-thyroidal illness.
